HUNT FEE: \$100 ADULT, \$50 JUNIOR (UNDER 18)

Important – Only Valley Waterfowl members who attended or contributed to the 2025 Outdoorsman's Dinner are eligible to participate in the Hunt Program. Applications must be received by Valley Waterfowl at least **14 days prior** to selected hunt dates. Up to six hunters are allowed in a hunt group and all hunters in the group must be listed on the same application. Hunters may only apply with one hunt group. A completed **release of liability form** must be submitted for each hunter listed on the application. Single hunters (not in a hunt group) will be assigned to an individual seat in a blind with other hunters.

Rules of Conduct

- Hunters will abide by all state and federal fish and game laws and as well all other state and federal laws.
- Only Valley Waterfowl Members who have a hunt application on file are allowed in the blinds. Outside guests are not allowed.
- Overnight camping on the property is prohibited.
- Hunters will only access their designated blind on the date assigned.
- Hunters are not allowed cut the natural cover around the blinds.
- If you adjust the decoy spread, you must return the spread to the original configuration before you vacate the blind.
- No alcohol is allowed in the blind and hunters who have consumed alcohol are not allowed in the blind.
- No shooting is allowed prior to one half hour before sunrise or after sunset.
- No skyscraping and thus, no complaints from neighboring blinds about skyscraping.
- Avoid low shots that may strike decoys.
- Upland game hunting on the property is prohibited.
- Vicious or uncontrolled dogs are not allowed on the property.
- Remove all trash and expended shell casings from in and around the blind (even if they are not yours).
- When your hunt is complete and before you leave the property, text a hunt report to 209 481 3554.
- The hunt report should include how many ducks and geese were taken, any damage to the blind, cover or decoys and any trash, shell casings, etc... found in or around the blind.
- Failure to abide by these rules of conduct may result in the suspension of hunting privileges or expulsion from Valley Waterfowl.

Hunting Location - if you have a preferred blind location, check the box. You may check them all if you like. Your preference will be considered, but there are no guarantees you will be assigned to a specific blind.

Hunt Dates - Check the box next to the days you prefer to hunt. Saturdays, Sunday and Wednesdays. If you would like to reserve a blind for a specific date, (special weekend, holiday, school break etc...) check the box next to those dates. Again, no guarantees. **Storm Days:** Blinds are available on storm days. A storm day is when the National Weather Service forecasts wind at the blind site of 10 miles per hour or more. You may request to hunt a storm day up to five days in advance, however, blind assignments are usually made about 72 hours in advance.
